HOW TO USE

MAGIC ODOUR DIGESTER is used directly from the bottle as a ready to go solution and requires no dilution with water.

- Particularly effective for the self-catering holiday accommodation and residential care sectors or rooms which may have poor ventilation.
- Spray liberally over the affected area to remove foul odours. Wipe to clean or simply leave to dry, there is no need to rinse after use.

- Care should be taken to avoid breathing vapours. Ensure that the product is directed into the air as you leave the room, caravan, chalet or toilet.
- Best results are achieved when the product is used as part of a hygiene routine, allowing soil deposits to be safely penetrated and digested.

SAFETY ADVICE

Not classified as hazardous, however we advise that normal cleaning safety practices are adopted. Wear rubber gloves when handling and avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention if irritation persists.
